Key Vocabulary

environment	Everything around us, including the air, soil, water, plants and animals.
next to/ far	Language to describe position and distance.
office	A room of building used for professional work.
house	A building for humans to live in, usually with more than one floor.
compass	A tool for finding directions, with the 4 main arrows pointing to North, South, East and West..
aerial view	The view from a height above an object or place, sometimes also called 'birds-eye view'.
distance	The amount of space between two places.
landmark	A feature of a place which is easily recognised, for example, a bridge, a tower, a church spire.
community	A particular area where a group of people live.
route	A way from one place to another.
symbol	An object or picture which represents something.
map	A drawing of a place showing where each feature is.
human/physical features	Something which has harmful or poisonous effects in the environment.



Knowledge and skills

- Know that Anfield is where we live and it is a part of the city of Liverpool.
- Know what we mean when we say 'human' and 'physical' features, and to locate some in the Anfield area.
- Know how to describe the position of landmarks and routes to reach them using directional language.
- Know that we can study landmarks (including the park, stadium and school) by using OS maps with symbols and aerial view photographs.
