Christian	Someone who believes in and follows the teachings of Jesus Christ.
Mission Statement	A formal summary of the aims and values of a company, organisation, or individual.
Values	Principles or standards of behaviour; one's judgement of what is important in life.
Agape love	Love originating from God or Christ for humankind.
Self-sacrificial love	Sacrifice of one's personal interest or well-being for the sake of others or for love.
Forgiveness	The action or process of forgiving or being forgiven.
Justice	The quality of being fair and reasonable.
Fairness	Impartial and just treatment or behaviour without favouritism or discrimination.
Generosity	The quality of being kind and generous.
Greed	Intense and selfish desire for something, especially wealth, power, or food.
