


Year 4-What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today?

Christian	A person who believes in God and his son Jesus.
Christ	Jesus is the son of God. People called him Christ.
Faith	What it means to be a loyal follower
Community	How people live in a particular area.
Holy Communion	Bread and wine received during Mass to remember Jesus' death.
Pope Francis	The leader of the Catholic Church. He lives in Rome.
Worship	To pray and sing songs to God in church or at home.
Sacrifice	When you give something up e.g. Jesus gave his life on the cross.
Priest	A teacher of God
Cross	Reminds Christians that Jesus died on the cross.
