- Encourage healthy lifestyles such as healthy lunchboxes and engaging children in sporting activities both at home and in school.

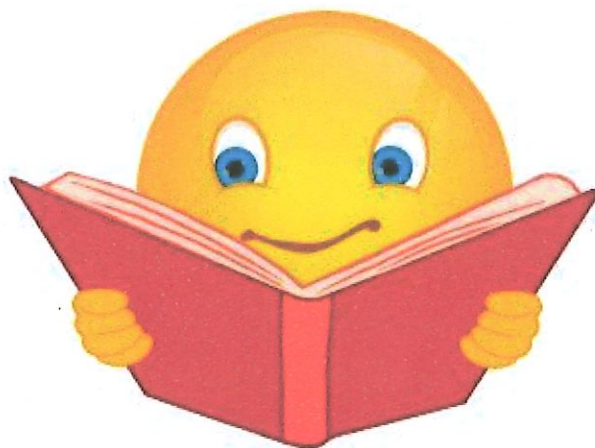


## Reading Ambassadors
