Year 3 Sports Day

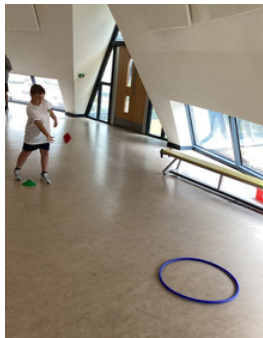
