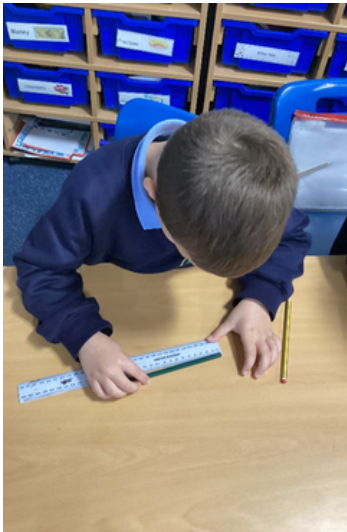


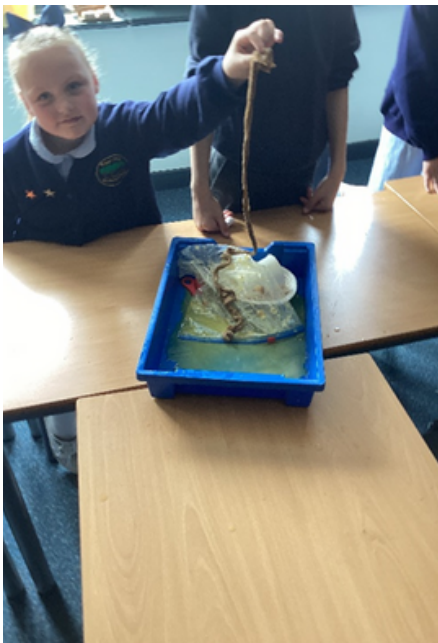
YEAR 2 - MEASUREMENT

A Champion in Four Oaks

We have a talented athlete in our school!

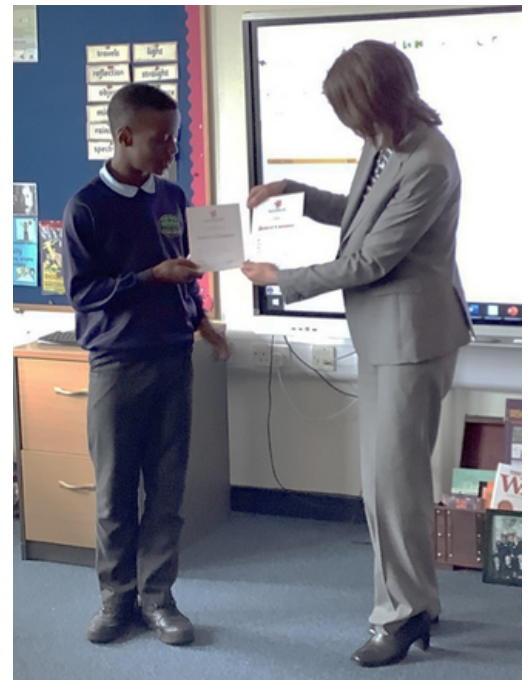
Sa'ad's athletic talent was first spotted when Liverpool Harriers Athletic Club started coaching Year 5 in April 2023. Through regular training sessions, he soon established himself as part of the successful Liverpool Harriers Youth Development Team. A year later, he is now District Athletic Champion in 75m sprints and high jump. Let's see how this all started!

Becoming an athlete takes dedication, determination and sheer hard work. Sa'ad trains twice a week with Liverpool Harriers at Wavertree Athletics Track. He is always well-prepared for his training sessions; he follows instructions well and he is a good team player. In fact, his team working ability and leadership skills, led to him being selected as team captain of the Sportshall League winning team in February 2024.

At the recent County Championships, Sa'ad won silver in 75m and bronze in 150m sprints. This was a tremendous achievement, as he competed against Year 7 boys from the 5 boroughs of Merseyside in the under 13 age group. Sa'ad has a personal best time of 10.6 seconds for the 75m sprint and 20 seconds for the 150cm sprint. This ranks him in 7th place in northwest England at this distance. Sa'ad also shows promise in high jump and his personal best at this event is 1m 30cm.

In June, Sa'ad competed for Four Oaks in the District Athletic Championships in the 75m sprint and the high jump winning both events and we have a District Champion in our school! By winning these events he qualifies to take part in the City Championships, which take place on 10th July.

We can't wait to see how he gets on. Good Luck Sa'ad, from everyone at Four Oaks!
