

Phonics in Year 1

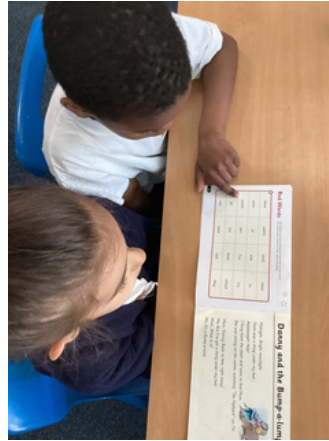
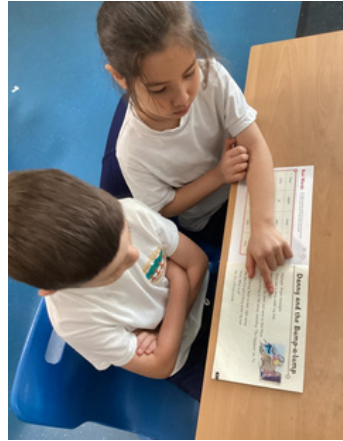
The children have been working very hard in preparation for their Phonics Screening Check next week. They have been trying very hard to learn all Set 2 and Set 3 sounds to ensure they have the tools they need to pass. In Year 1, the children learn to read accurately and begin to read fluently. By the end of the year, the children are expected to read a minimum of 60 words per minute.

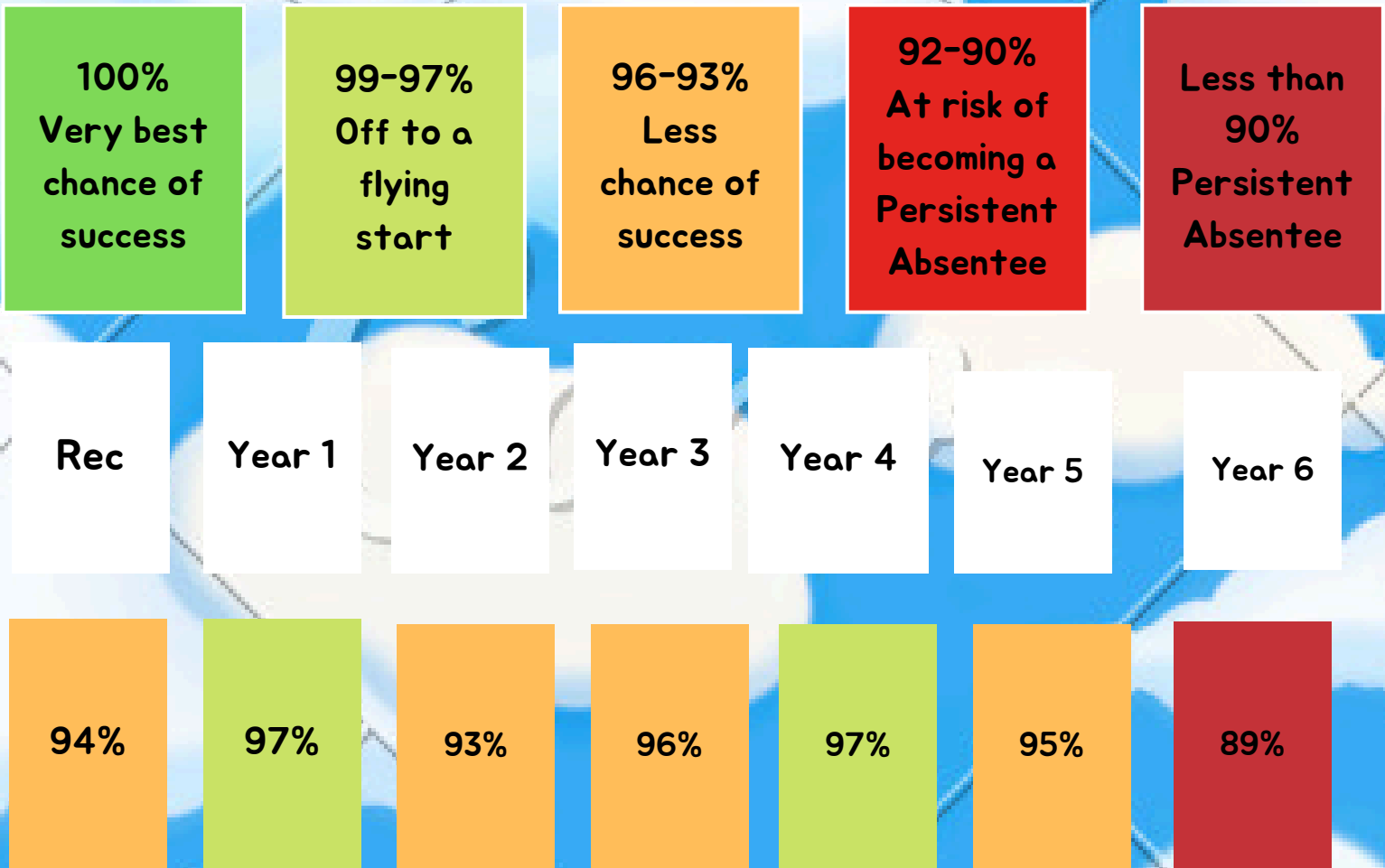
