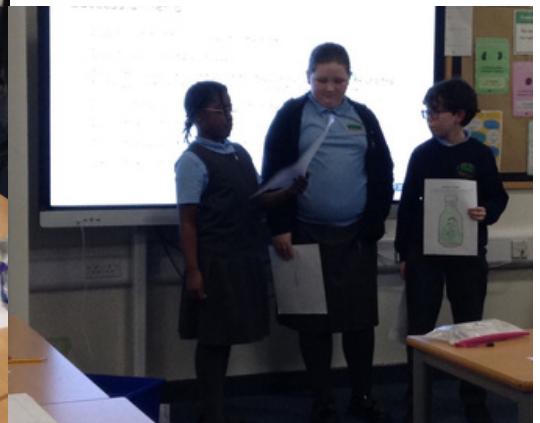
Little Acorns and Superheroes
