

Year 4 – Art

In our art lessons this week we have been exploring different techniques we can use to create shapes and textures with watercolour paints, looking at hot and cold colours and exploring how we can create vibrant images using contrasting colours. We have been inspired by the work of impressionist artists like Claude Monet and have been using the colours, shapes, and brushstrokes in his work to help us develop our confidence in using paints to create landscapes. Now that we are confident in our painting skills, we are going to be creating our own landscape paintings of different parts of Liverpool using Monet paintings to inspire us.



Year 2 - Science

In science, year 2 have been learning all about animals and their habitats. This week we thought of different types of habitats such as woodland, the rainforest and the ocean and the types of animals we would find in these places. We discussed the adaptations that different animals have that help them to survive in specific habitats and in our groups, we created our own animals using playdough. We made sure to include the adaptations these animals would have, and the rest of the class had to guess what habitat they might belong to.
