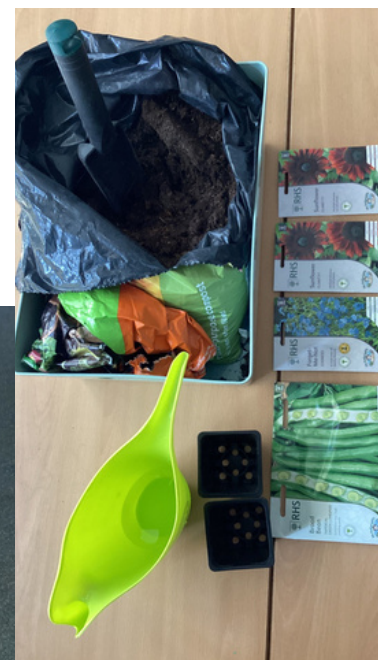
"I love this style of music as it makes me want to move and smile!" (Bobby-Jay)
