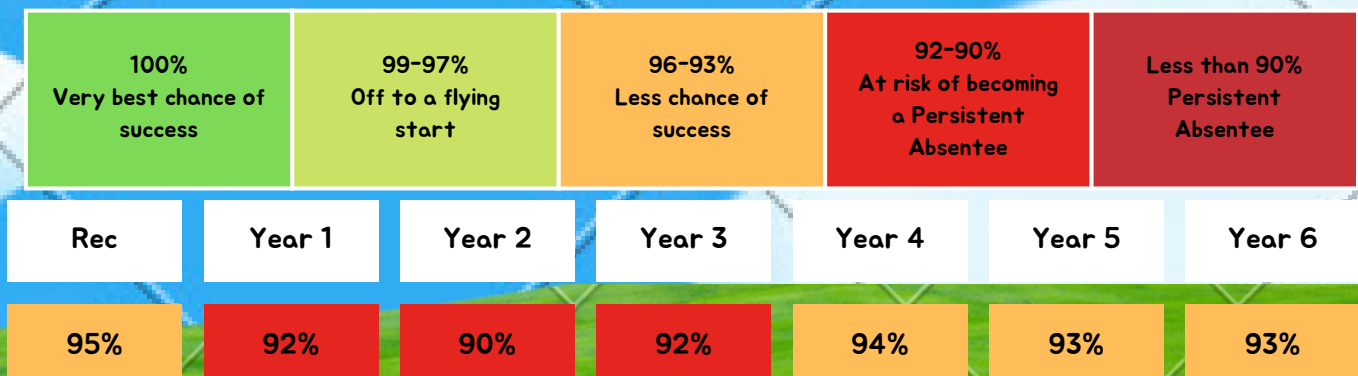
Alfie A - 'The trip to Martin Mere was very fun and exciting. We saw a lot of different animals.'
