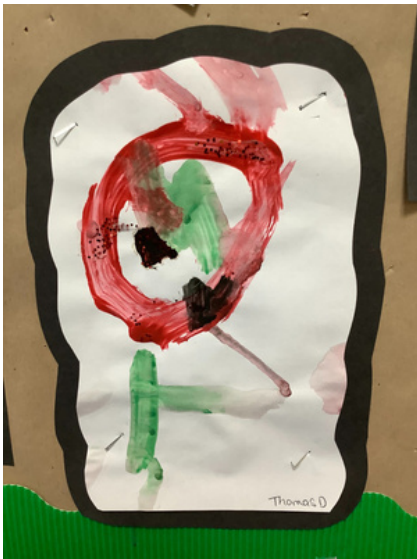

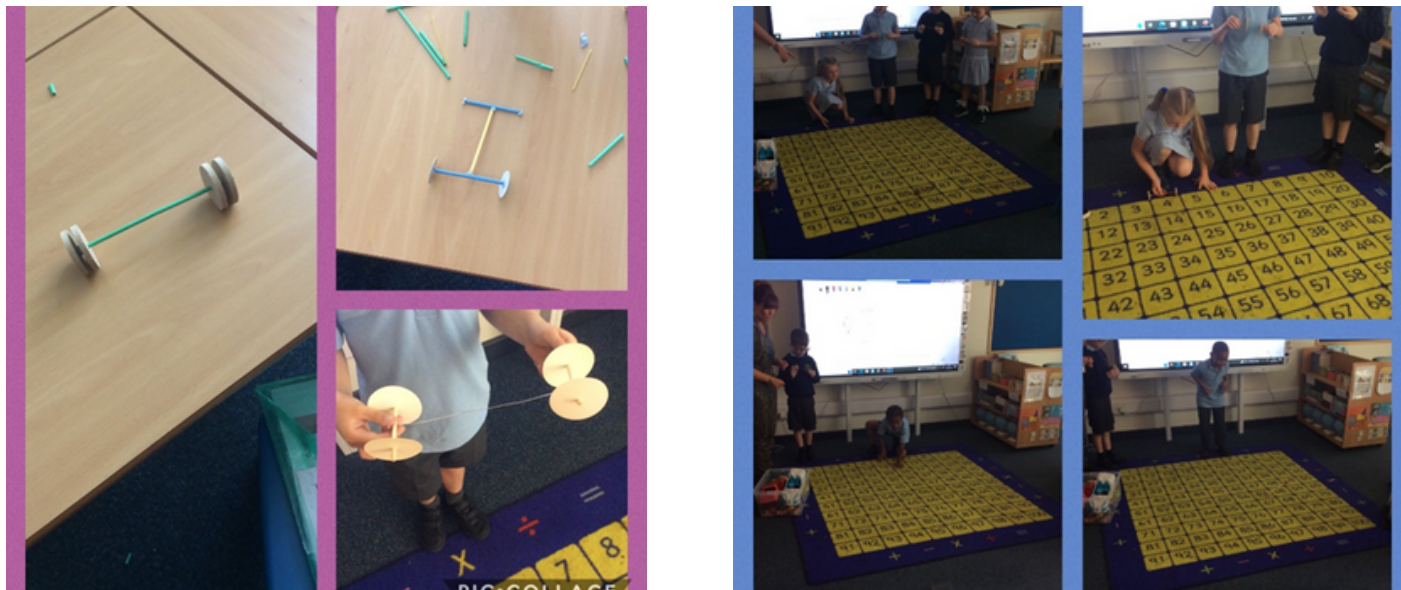
## Exploring the outdoor environment with Nursery

In Nursery this term we have enjoyed exploring the outdoor environment. We noticed new flowers growing and went to investigate using magnifying glasses. We discovered beautiful poppies blooming in the raised beds. The contrast of red and black colours against the green stems stood out to the children. The children asked if we could paint our own poppies. Whilst painting we discussed the features of a poppy such as the stem, petals and leaves. The children used new vocabulary to describe the flowers such as “delicate” and “beautiful”. Some children linked this to their previous learning about Remembrance Day in November.
