

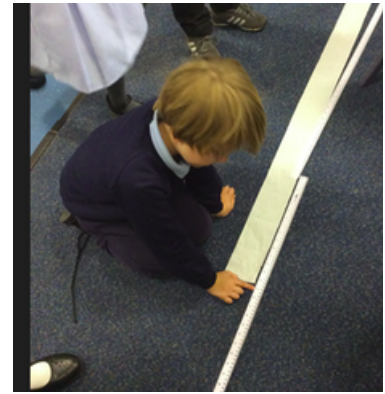

YEAR 3 HISTORY

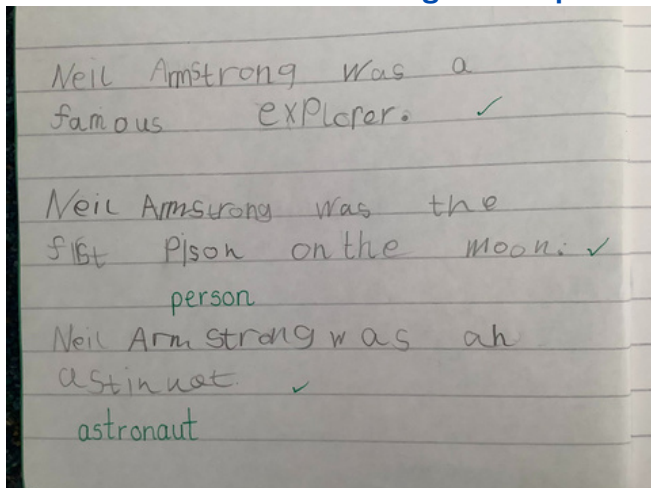

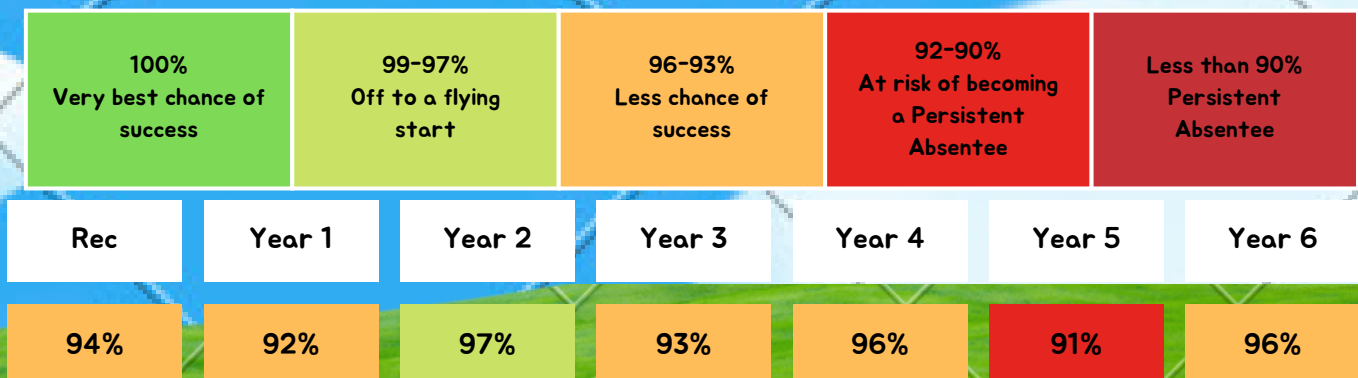
