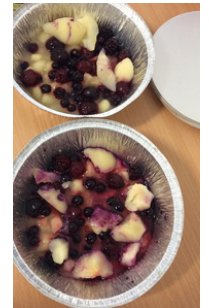
## Six Year 6 Children celebrate major Anfield Road Stand milestone.
