We love our climbing frames and slides and our fantastic wood carving sculpture trail.

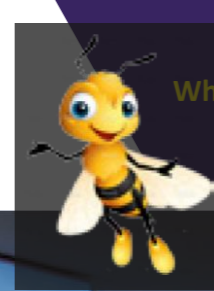

Our technology is awesome!

We have everything from computerised Lego to iPads that can make 2D pictures turn into moving 4D models using augmented reality. All the children have access to Smart Boards, laptops, iPads, iPods and cameras to make learning powerful and fun. We have programmable robots too. Our computer suite has hidden PCs which pop out of study desks at the push of a button. Computer programming is easy for us!

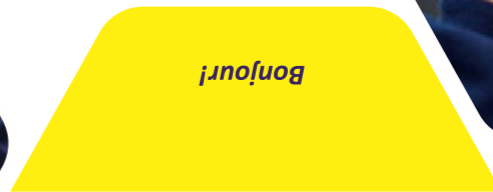
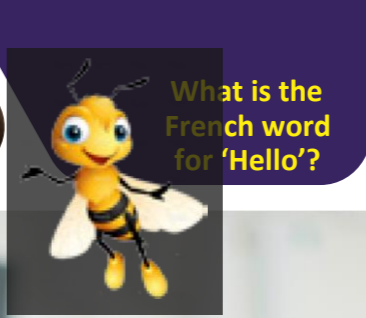
Our curriculum

The teachers make learning fun!

Four Oaks offers all National Curriculum subjects supported by specialist music teachers, dance and sports coaches. We also have both French and Mandarin speaking teachers to help us with our Modern Foreign Languages. We often invite speakers, theatre groups, Scientists and Design & Technology workshops into school to enhance our learning.

You are never too young to start learning; so for example, French lessons start in Reception and swimming lessons start from Year 1, continuing throughout your time in Four Oaks. We have lots of teaching support in each class so all the children get a huge amount of help.

Our minibuses make school visits easy. Sometimes we travel locally such as to the library, parks or sports fixtures and sometimes we travel further afield such as to Chester or Southport for History and Geography trips.



Clubs & trips

Clubs and trips are a great way to make more friends and to try something new!

In the Allotment club we grow our own food and use it to cook tasty dishes and in Sewing club we make teddy bears and cross stitch pictures. Art club, which is run with Bluecoat Arts Centre, is another favourite too. Other clubs include Lego club, Guitar club, Film club and lots of sports clubs.

For our annual residential trips Year 6 love their visit to the Isle of Man. A trip on the ferry across the Irish Sea starts the adventure before being taken up to the Venture Centre for water sports, orienteering, archery and much more. Colomendy outdoor pursuits is a favourite for Year 4 and 5 children. For our younger children, an overnight stay at Crosby Lakeside Centre for fun water sports and orienteering is a big success!

People often comment on our beautiful hall with its curved walls and sprung sports floor and we even have covered upstairs 'playdecks' so we can enjoy sports whatever the weather.

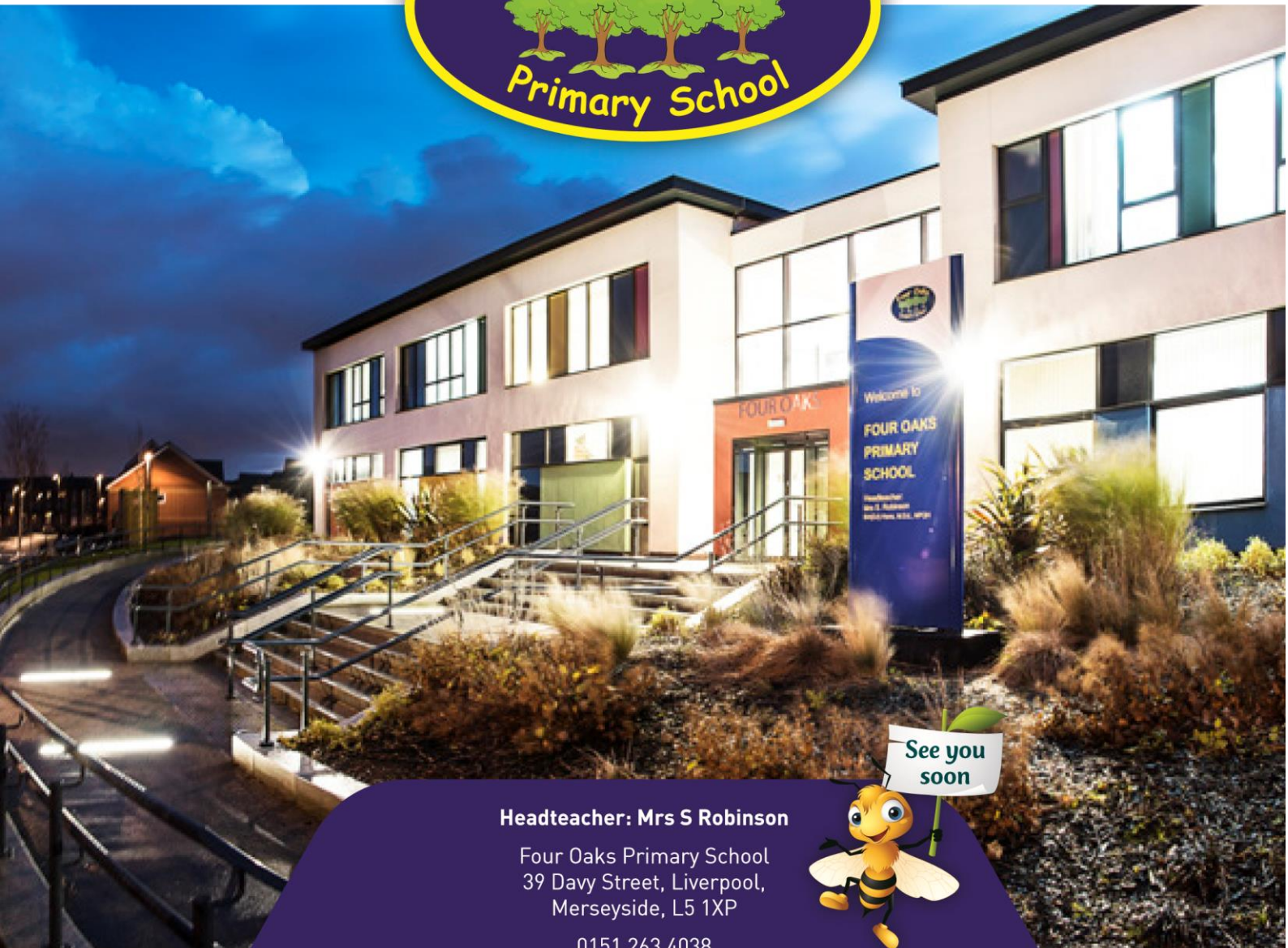
